SECTION 5.10A Addendum to Drug and Alcohol Free Workplace

Marijuana (medical or adult use cannabis)

The Jefferson County Board of Developmental Disabilities (JCBDD) has a zero-tolerance policy for employees who are under the influence of illegal drugs and alcohol while at work. For purposes of this policy, employees who use medical marijuana pursuant to a medical marijuana card under ORC chapter 3796 or who use, possess, or distribute adult use cannabis in compliance with ORC Chapter 3780 are not exempt from this policy in any way. The use of marijuana in any form, with or without a card or compliance with Ohio law, will be treated the same as the use of all other controlled substances, illegal drugs, or the abuse of legal drugs.

JCBDD is not required to permit or accommodate an employee's use, possession or distribution of either medical marijuana or adult use cannabis. JCBDD is permitted by law to refuse to hire, discharge, discipline, or otherwise take an adverse employment action against an individual with respect to hire, tenure, terms, conditions, or privileges of employment with JCBDD because of that individual's use, possession, or distribution of either medical marijuana or adult use cannabis. An employee's use, possession or distribution of adult use cannabis in JCBDD's buildings and on JCBDD's grounds is prohibited, and employees are not permitted to use medical marijuana or adult use cannabis while on lunch or other breaks.
